Resolution Supporting Tire Safety Awareness

- 2 WHEREAS, data from the Federal Highway Administration¹ (FHWA) indicates U.S. motorists traveled
- 3 more than 3.2 trillion miles on tires in 2021, and
- 4 WHEREAS, maintaining proper tire pressure, periodically rotating and balancing tires according to the
- 5 vehicle manufacturer's recommendations (typically every 5,000-7,500 miles), and regularly inspecting
- 6 tires can help prevent irregular and premature tire wear, and
- 7 WHEREAS, excessively worn tires are more susceptible to punctures and hydroplaning in wet
- 8 conditions, and
- 9 WHEREAS, proper tread depth helps tires maintain traction and improves handling, and
- 10 WHEREAS, tire tread depth may be checked using a tread depth gauge or simply by inserting an upside
- 11 down penny into the tread to verify it covers at least a portion of President Lincoln's head, and
- 12 WHEREAS, under inflation is one of the primary causes of tire disablement and tire failure, and
- 13 underinflated tires can make controlling your car more difficult, reduce gas mileage, lead to excessive
- 14 heat build-up and stress, cause irregular wear and internal damage.
- 15 WHEREAS, overinflated tires are more likely to be cut, punctured or damaged when hitting an 16 obstacle, such as a pothole, and
- 17 WHEREAS, the U.S. Tire Manufacturers Association recommends drivers regularly check their tire
- 18 tread depth, ensure that tires are rotated and properly aligned, and check their tire pressure monthly
- 19 using a tire gauge while the tires are cold meaning the car has not been driven for three hours, and
- WHEREAS, a vehicle's proper tire pressure is affixed to the vehicle's door jamb next to the driver's seat and contained in the vehicle owner's manual, and
- 22 WHEREAS, motorists should visually scan their tires for cuts, cracks, splits, punctures, and bulges, and
- 23 visit a tire professional to assist with any of these conditions, and
- 24 WHEREAS, spending just a few minutes each month to inspect and maintain your vehicle's tires can
- 25 make all the difference in your tires' safety, life, and performance, and

- 31 Tire Safety Week annually, each year that this resolution is in effect.
